The FASS is planning a BOTTLE DRIVE for later in April. Start saving your bottles, and we'll provide more details as the date approaches.



Complete your Returning Student Registration: February 10-24 Elk Island Public Schools'

EIPS <u>returning student registration</u> process is now open. All current students, except Grade 12, must complete the online Returning Student Registration Form to confirm their enrolment in a school and program for the upcoming 2025-26 school year. Additionally, students who want to attend a non-designated school or program need to make that request through the returning student registration process—acceptance is based on available space. All current EIPS students are required to complete the form by Feb. 24, 2025.

To complete your child's returning student registration, refer to the Returning Student Registration Form email you received from Elk Island Public Schools through Permission Click on February 10. Families will receive one email for each student. No log in is required to complete the form.


